

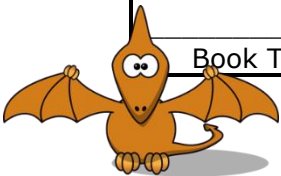

# Join New Gloucester Public Library for the 2022 Library Book Bingo reading challenge!

Library Book Bingo is the NGPL's reading challenge for 2022. Adults, teens, and children can all participate—and win prizes!

## How do I get one of these Library Book Bingo cards?

Download a card at [www.newgloucesterlibrary.org/bingo](http://www.newgloucesterlibrary.org/bingo) or pick one up at the Library. Use the card for your age: children (0 - 12), teens (13 - 17), adults (18+).

## How do I play?

- Keep track of the library books you read (or have read to you) in 2022 and write the title and author in the matching square.
- A title can only be used **once** on the Bingo card.

## Does it matter what format I read?

No. Physical books, e-books, audiobooks, or e-audiobooks can be used to complete the challenge. You can read children's, young adult, or adult books—no matter your age.

## How do I win?

**BINGO:** Complete a horizontal, vertical, or diagonal line! You'll get 1 entry for a \$25 gift card from a local bookstore per bingo completed. Three \$25 gift cards will be awarded: one for adults, one for teens, and one for children.

**Blackout:** Complete all 25 squares and you'll also be entered in a drawing for the Grand Prize, a \$100 gift card from a local bookstore.

Books must be read between January 1 and December 31, 2022.

Return your Bingo card (or a copy) by January 15, 2023:

*Fine Print: Multiple cards allowed per person, but each card must have different books. Entrants must use the card for their age on December 31, 2022: children (0 - 12), teens (13 - 17), adults (18+). Prizes will be drawn the week of 1/16/23. The Grand Prize will be drawn before other prizes. Maximum of one prize per person. Prize winners must have a New Gloucester Public Library card (Free to New Gloucester, Gray, Pownal and Durham residents) in good standing. NGPL staff and their households may participate but are ineligible to win prizes.*
